

Finishing Carpenter, Construction (Squamish, BC)

We are looking for an experienced and detail-oriented Finishing Carpenter to assist in the finishing stages of single-family projects in Squamish. The position will report to Superintendent, and coordinate with the customer services team and trades to deliver projects on time and on budget and ensure compliance with safety regulations. This is a full-time position. The work location is in Squamish, BC.

Responsibilities:

- Read blueprints and designs prepared by architects and construction professionals, and ensure they meet building code recommendations and requirements.
- Check and inspect deficiencies with Superintendent and record all the deficiencies that need to be completed
- Carry out quantity estimates of raw materials required for a finishing project.
- The final touch to the projects before and after internal inspections to ensure the projects meet the standard of quality.
- Take measurements to develop a suitable layout for a fixture
- Prepare wood structures for finishing by shaping and trimming with hand or power tools
- Assemble wooden components to fabricate useful structures such as desks, and shelves
- Carry out measurement and installation of wooden floorings
- Provide varnishing and staining service for woodwork
- Implement safety and health regulations during work operations to ensure an environmentally friendly and safe structure

Qualifications:

- At least 2-year experience in a similar role with finishing, and completing quality control on residential projects.
- An eye for detail and a desire to achieve high standards of completion.
- Ability to use hand and power tools, including drills, saws, nail guns, chisels and sander.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to work under pressure to tight deadlines.
