

Project Manager, Construction (Vancouver, BC)

We are looking for an experienced and task-oriented Construction Project Manager to supervise our projects in BC. The position will need to monitor and motivate construction crews to deliver projects on time and on budget and ensure compliance with safety regulations. This position will directly report to the Senior Vice President of Construction, and maintain clear and efficient communication between management and the construction crews. This is a full-time position and requires travel to project sites within BC.

Responsibilities:

- Reviewing the work of the construction crew to determine whether quality standards are being observed
- Developing a plan of work for each site so each project can finish on time
- Reporting to Senior Management about the cost and progress of each project
- Managing the budget for each worksite to make sure each project is completed efficiently
- Planning the work to be done, getting the necessary personnel, and assigning the right duties to the right people
- Coordinating tasks by different people on different sites to ensure uniformity upon project completion
- Ensuring timely completion of the project to build client trust while avoiding unnecessary penalties
- Procuring and allocating resources to ensure there is no shortage while avoiding any unnecessary delays caused by management decisions
- Managing both internal and external risks within the project's lifetime, such as poor planning designs, and government policies, which directly or indirectly affect the project
